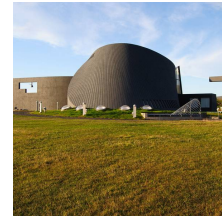
## 2. Blönduós

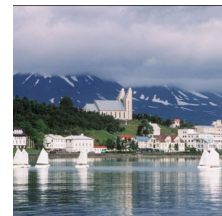
