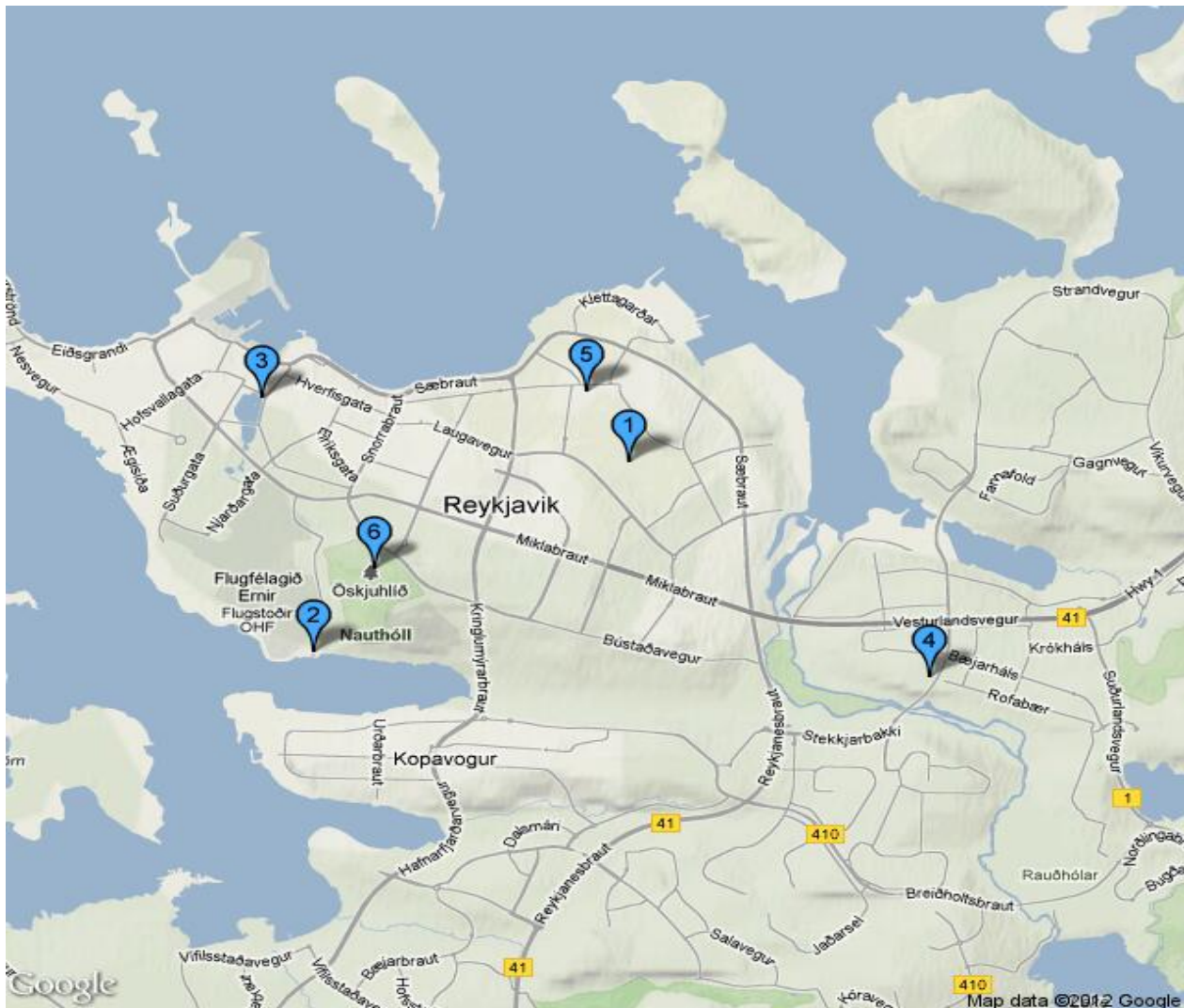

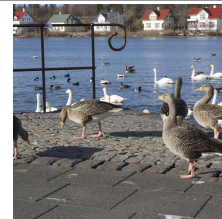

The best known swimming pool in Iceland and the biggest one.

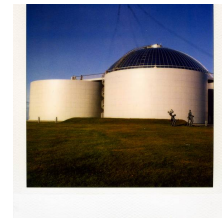
6. Perlan
